### **Mongolia Trophy Hunts**

If you are an international sheep or ibex hunter this is must destination. The ibex hunting in the Altai and Gobi is excellent with success being 100% for the past several years. The Gobi ibex will be in the 35"-40" class while the Altai will average in the 40"-45" class with several taken each year in the upper 40's and low 50's. The largest sheep in the world, Altai Argali along with the Hangai and Gobi Argali are the main attractions to this remote country. If you want the ultimate sheep hunt for the biggest sheep –this is it! Depending on the area, these species will be in the 40"-60" range with 16"-20" bases!! This is not just a great hunt, but an experience that you soon not forget!

### **Marco Polo Sheep in Tajikistan**

Hunt what many big game hunters consider the number 1 trophy in the world. Our outfitter has been producing exceptional rams in this area for many years. Success has been 100% on rams in the 55" – 62" class with an occasional one in the mid-60's. The camps are located about 13,000 feet and are warm, comfortable and have generators for power. Hunting is basically done on foot once your trophy is located. Most hunts take place around 14,000 feet with shots ranging from 300-500 yards. Don't pass up the opportunity to hunt one of the most magnificent big game trophies in the world. Permits are very limited for these hunts.

**Rates:** \$34,000 7-day 1X1 Marco Polo sheep hunt

**Dates:** September – December 15

**Includes:** Lodging, services of professional guide, meals, in-field transportation & field preparation of game.

## Giant Moose in Russia

The Chukotka moose is the largest antlered animal in the world. This hunt takes place in the Koryak region and in the central part of the Kamchatka Peninsula. The average bull has been around 61 inches with several bulls in the 70" – 72" class taken each year. These bulls can be found in the low valleys up to tree line. Hunters will be accommodated in tented camps or cabins depending on the area hunted. If a big bull moose is on your list and you're looking for a real international adventure, this is your hunt. Now booking for 2009 & 2010 hunting season.

**Rates:** \$12,000 10-day 1X1 moose hunt

**Dates:** September – December 15

**Includes:** Lodging, services of professional guide, interpreter, meals, in-field transportation, & field preparation of game.

**Not Included:** Commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to hunt, firearm import/export permit, trophy shipping fees & gratuities.

**Transportation:** Fly to Moscow and then onto Petropavlovsk where you will be met by the outfitter.

## Kamchatka Brown Bear

The Kamchatka Peninsula has been producing trophy brown bear for many years. Our outfitter has over 15 years experience producing bears in the 9' – 10' range. The spring is the prime time to hunt these bears while there is snow on the ground and traveling is easy. Snow mobiles are used to cover the great distances looking for a track of a trophy bear. Once the bear is located, the hunt is by foot and shooting distances can vary from 100 – 200 yards. The camps are warm, clean polar tents or cabins equipped with stoves and cots. Each camp has an interpreter, cook and generator. If you are looking for the opportunity to take a really nice bear and have a true Asian experience, this is your hunt.

**Rates:** \$11,000 9-day 1X1 brown bear hunt  
\$5,000 \*Second Bear

**Dates:** April - May

**Includes:** Service of professional guide, interpreter, helicopter charter, accommodations, meals, in-field transportation & field preparation of game.

**Not Included:** Commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to hunt, firearm import/export permit, individual helicopter transfers, trophy shipping fees & gratuities.

## Siberian Roe Deer

The Siberian roe deer is one of the largest species of roe deer in the world. This area of Russia has a very strong population of deer which enables the hunter to take 2-3 bucks with exceptional heads. All hunting is done on foot using spot and stalk tactics as well as calling. Success is 100%. The camps are comfortable hunting lodges, motels or cabins and the hunting takes place in agricultural areas. If you love hunting whitetail deer, you will really enjoy hunting the Siberian roe deer. It's a fun, exciting and successful hunt for a very weary and elusive trophy.

**Rates:** \$2,550 5-day 1X1 roe deer hunt  
+ Trophy Fees (\$1300 - \$3300)
