BROWN BEAR

Alaskan Brown & Black Bear

This outfitter has been guiding in Alaska for over 25 years. The area he hunts his Brown Bear in is one of the best bear areas in Alaska. In 25 years of booking clients in to this area, our clients have been 100% in seeing bears ranging from 8 ½ feet to 9 ½ feet. What makes this area extra special is the opportunity to take a glacier bear. There are only 4 hunts available each season so make plans soon!

Rates: \$12,200 10-Day 2X1 brown bear & black bear hunt

Dates: April - May

Includes: Airport Pickup, 2X1 guide service, air charter, trophy preparation, meals and in-field accommodations.

Not Included: AK non-resident license approx: \$85, AK black bear tag approx:\$225 / trophy, air charter commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to hunt, dip, pack, crate and shipping of trophy(s) and gratuities.

Transportation: Fly into Yakutat via Anchorage, AK and charter into camp.

Alaskan Peninsula Brown Bear

This outfitter has been hunting the Alaskan Peninsula for trophy brown bear taking several outstanding bears over the last few seasons –the largest squaring 11'2"! Success on bears between 8 ½ - 10 foot has been 90%. This particular area has an incredible density of bear and has had very little hunting pressure allowing you to be selective. Furthermore this location is also known for its huge salmon which lure in these incredible coastal brown bears. You can rest assured that your guide will work hard to put you in the best position possible to help you succeed on your trophy quest.

Rates: \$15,200 10-day 1X1 coastal brown bear hunt

Dates: September

Includes: Airport pickup, air charter, 1X1 guide service, all food, tents, cots, cooking equipment, transportation of meat, capes and antlers back to Iliamna.

Not Included: AK non-resident license approx: \$85, AK brown bear tag approx: \$500, expediting skull, cape & meat from Iliamna, gratuities, hotels & meals prior to hunt, commercial flights, dip, pack, crate and shipping of trophy(s).

Transportation: Fly into Anchorage & overnight. Fly into Iliamna the following morning; outfitter to meet and greet upon arrival, then charter to camp.

Cold Bay's Big Brown Bear

Consistently taking big bears for over 20 years, this is without a doubt the best brown bear hunting in North America! Each year they take bears over 10 feet with an average of well-over 9 feet. In the spring of 2006 they took four bear over 10 feet and two had 29" skulls! Conducting hunts in both spring (even year) & fall (odd year) there are cheaper brown bear out there, but there is not a better hunt for big brown bear trophies than this one!

Rates: \$20,000 8-day 1x1 brown bear hunt 2010
\$25,000 16-day 1x1 brown bear hunt 2010

Dates: 2010 8-day hunt dates: May 10-17 & 18-25
2010 16-day hunt dates: May 10-25

Includes: 1x1 guide service, meals, accommodations, trophy care and all in-field transportation.

Not Included: AK non-resident license approx: \$85, AK brown bear tag approx: \$500, round-trip air charter \$750 / person, hotels & meals prior to hunt, commercial flights and gratuities.

Transportation: Fly into Cold Bay, AK & charter to camp.

Southeast Alaskan Brown Bear

You will have to look long and hard to find an outfitter/guide who will work harder to get you a trophy brown bear. With over 25 years experience hunting the ABC Islands, this outfitter has been over 90% successful on bears in the 8 ½ - 9 ½ class. This is a truly exciting hunt with new thrills around every corner.

Rates: \$16,500 13-day 1x1 brown bear 2010 hunt

Dates: April 23-May 5, May 9-20, 22-31, Sept. 14-26, Sept. 29-Oct. 11

Includes: Lodging, services of professional guide, meals, transportation on property, and field preparation of game.

Not Included: AK non-resident license approx: \$85, AK brown bear tag approx: \$500, hotels & meals prior to hunt and gratuities.

Transportation: Fly to Juneau, AK where outfitter will meet and transfer to hunting area.

Private Land Peninsula Brown Bear

This outfitter has exclusive hunting rights to over 88,000 acres of private native land in the heart of big bear country. The Alaskan peninsula produces the largest brown bear year after year and this outfitter consistently takes trophy bears for our clients. We do not know of a better value anywhere in Alaska for the opportunity to take a trophy brown bear.

Rates: \$15,500 spring: 7-day 1x1 brown bear
\$15,500 fall: 10-day 1x1 brown bear

Dates: Spring: May 10-16, 19-25, 2012
Fall: October 1 - 10, 12-21, 2011

Includes: Airport pickup, 1x1 guide service, meals and accommodations, field preparations of game.

Not Included: AK non-resident license approx: \$85, AK brown bear tag approx: \$500, expediting skull, cape & meat, gratuities, hotels & meals prior to hunt, commercial flights, dip, pack, crate and shipping of trophy(s).

Transportation: Fly into Anchorage and outfitter to meet and greet upon arrival.
