## CARIBOU

### **Alaskan Barren Ground Caribou**

Over the years, Alaska has been known for its great Barren Ground caribou hunting, however in some areas the herds are on the decline. The Western Arctic herd is the strongest herd in the state and that's exactly where we want to send you. Our outfitter has been hunting this area for several years and consistently produces some fantastic trophies.

**Rates:** \$6,000 5-day 2X1 caribou hunt  
\$3,150 5-day unguided caribou hunt

**Dates:** September

**Includes:** Airport pickup, 2X1 guide service, round-trip air charter all food, tents, cots, cooking equipment, transportation of meat, capes and antlers back to Kotzebue.

**Not Included:** Alaskan hunting license approx: \$85, Alaskan caribou tag approx: \$325, expediting antlers, capes & meat from Kotzebue, gratuities, hotels & meals prior to hunt, commercial flights, dip, pack, crate and shipping of trophies.

**Transportation:** Fly into Anchorage and overnight. Fly into Kotzebue the following morning; outfitter to meet and greet upon arrival, then charter to camp.

### **Arctic Island Caribou**

From mid-October to almost mid-November herds of Arctic Islands caribou move into the south-east corner of Victoria Island. The caribou are often seen just outside of Cambridge Bay; even on the runway of the airport!!! Many clients have seen hundreds of caribou during their hunt with this outfitter. There isn't a more beautiful caribou than that of the snow-white Arctic Island caribou!

**Rates:** \$6,500 5 Days 1X1 caribou hunt  
\$7,500 Arctic Island caribou & muskox Hunt  
\$1,500 second muskox fee

**Dates:** October - November

**Includes:** Transportation from Cambridge Bay to hunting area by snowmobile; the services of an experienced, licensed guide with a snowmobile, all food and accommodations, field preparation of the trophy.

**Not Included:** 5% Canada GST, commercial flights, license fee of approx: \$50 Canadian + 5% tax/ animal and gov't trophy fee approx: \$150 + 5% tax/trophy, hunting preservation fund approx: \$150, Canadian firearms import license approx: \$25, rental of down-filled pants and parka approx: \$125, hotels and meals prior to hunt and gratuities.

**Transportation:** Fly into Edmonton then onto Cambridge Bay where you will be met by outfitter.

## Quebec Labrador Caribou

Quebec-Labrador caribou is one of the nicest trophies in North America. Adult bulls weight between 300 and 400 pounds and carry antlers 45 to 60 inches wide. This outfitter has been hunting in this area longer than any other outfitter around, and has proven to be over 98% successful. There are now around 1,000,000 caribous in Northern Quebec; consequently they consistently put bulls in the B&C, P&Y, and SCI record books.

**Rates:** \$5,745 6-day 6x1 semi-guided caribou hunt

\$6,245 6-day 3x1 guided caribou hunt

\$7,245 6-day 2x1 guided caribou hunt

\$8,245 6-day 1x1 guided caribou hunt

**Dates:** Mid- August to early October

**Includes:** Professional guide, return airfare from Montreal, return charter transportation from Kuujjuaq to camp, all applicable taxes, lodging, meals, field preparation of game.

**Not Included:** Commercial flights (to Montreal), hotels & meals prior to hunt, caribou hunting permit pprox: \$300 & trophy shipping and gratuities.

**Transportation:** Fly to Montreal where you will be met and transferred by way of commercial jet & charter to camp.

## Central Canadian Caribou

Located in the Central Barren Ground Caribou's migration route and grazing area this remote paradise is an unexplored territory rich with trophy caribou. With 8-10 man mini-lodges situated about as far north as you can go in Manitoba, you will be poised to intercept the migrating caribou masses as they dash for the shelter of the boreal forests. Hunting the mighty Boo out of one of their tundra lodges is sure to be one of your most memorable big game adventures as this outfitter enjoys a 100% success rate year after year.

**Rates:** \$6,395 5-day 2X1 caribou hunt

**Dates:** September – October

**Includes:** Transportation from Churchill to Schmok/C.W. Lake, accommodations in modern mini-lodges, meals, beverages, services of professional guides, caping and packaging of meat, hunting opportunities for wolf, black bear, ptarmigan & geese, fishing for trophy Northern pike, lake trout and arctic grayling.

**Not Included:** Canada GST, tags & licenses, commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to hunt and gratuities.

**Transportation:** Fly to Churchill, Manitoba where you will be met and transferred by way of charter to camp.
