DALL SHEEP

Trophy Yukon Dall Sheep

Our outfitter has been operating and guiding hunters in this area for over 20 years and consistently produces trophy rams. This 6000 square mile concession is located in the best Dall sheep range in the Yukon. These mountain ranges are gentle enough that guides and hunters have the luxury of riding horseback above sheep. The outfitter has exceptional sheep guides, great camps and an excellent string of horses. Hunter success is very high on rams from 36" to 40"+. The outfitter and his guides will work very hard to ensure a successful and memorable hunt.

Rates: \$16,800 12 day 1x1 Dall sheep hunt

Dates: July 30-September 12

Includes: Meals, lodging, horses or boats, 1x1 guide service, field care of trophies & meat, round trip air charter, license, tag, GST tax, government royalties.

Not Included: All commercial flights, meals and lodging before and after hunt & gratuities.

Transportation: Fly to Whitehorse, overnight and charter to camp.

Dall Sheep in the Alaskan Range

This outfitter has been consistently producing trophy rams for clients over the past 20 years. The area in the Alaska Range near Denali National Park has had a 95% success on rams averaging 37"; each year they take rams in and near the 40" range. Not only does this area hold an excellent population of sheep, but the outfitter and his staff, consider it their primary objective to ensure you are successful in obtaining a trophy Dall ram. Caribou are also available on this hunt.

Rates: \$12,000 10-Day 1x1 Alaskan Dall sheep hunt

Dates: August 8th - 18th, 9 hunting-days & August 12th - 22nd, 9 hunting-days

Includes: 1x1 guide service, lodging, meals & field preparation of game.

Not Included: Commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to hunt, non-resident Alaska hunting license approx: \$85, Dall sheep tag approx: \$425, charter fees approx: \$700 & gratuities.

Transportation: Fly into McGrath, AK & charter to camp the next day.

Alaskan Horseback Dall Sheep Hunts

This outfitter has been guiding in Alaska for many years; because of his dedication to wildlife and expertise in conducting great hunts, his success rates continue to climb! This Dall sheep hunt is exceptionally successful because of the hard-working string of mountain horses they maintain in their stables. Hunted in the Alaska Range, in 2005 they boasted a 100% success rate with an average of 36" and up!

Rates: \$14,800 10-Day 1x1 Alaskan Dall sheep hunt

Dates: August - September

Includes: Accommodations, guide service, use of horses, meals & field preparation of game.

Not Included: Commercial flights, charter flight fees approx: \$700, hotels & meals prior to & after hunt, AK Non-resident hunting license (\$85), Dall sheep tag approx: \$425, & gratuities.

Transportation: Fly to Fairbanks, AK, overnight and the following day charter to hunting area.

Dall Sheep in the Brooks Range

With almost 30 years of outfitting Alaskan hunts this outfitter's experience is second to none. Utilizing horses in the Brooks Range makes this Dall sheep hunt less physical than most other areas of Alaska and Canada. Holding a healthy population of Dall rams, their average runs 36" – 40" range taking rams over 40" each year. With a 90% success rate, it's easy to say that this is a fantastic Dall sheep hunting area!

Rates: \$14,000 10-Day 1x1 Alaskan Dall sheep hunt

Dates: August 10-September 25

Includes: 1x1 guide service, lodging, meals, and field preparation of game.

Not Included: Commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to hunt, non-resident AK hunting license approx: \$85, Dall sheep tag approx: \$425, charter fee approx: \$900 & gratuities.

Transportation: Fly into Bettles, AK, overnight & charter to camp the next day.

Northwest Territories Trophy Dall Sheep

This outfitter is one of eight in the NWT that hold the rights to guide non-resident hunters in an area of approximately 9000 square miles! This outfitter has done consistently well in producing trophy rams which average 37" – 40" and each year they take 3-7 rams over 40" with a 95% success rate! The mountains are approximately 3500' to 9000' with terrain ranging from easy climbing, low rolling mountains to rugged peaks that can offer anyone a challenge, but you will have the assistance of a pack-dog team. If you're looking for an exceptional trophy dall sheep, this is the place to do it!

Rates: \$15,500 12-day 1x1 Dall sheep hunt
\$3,500 add-on mountain caribou

Dates: July - August

Includes: Accommodations, services of professional guide, use of dogs, meals, transportation on property & field preparation of game.

Not Included: Canada GST, commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to & after hunt, license approx: \$50 each specie, tag fee approx: \$200 for sheep & caribou each (pay upon harvest), charter approx: \$700 round-trip.

Transportation: Fly to Norman Wells, NWT & charter to camp.
