New Mexico Trophy Elk

Located on a world-class 36,000 acre ranch in northern New Mexico. This destination has a magnificent lodge with some of North America's finest elk hunting. This hunt is for the trophy seeker who wants to come home to the finest amenities at the end of the day's hunt. Hunters have been 95% successful with 100% shooting opportunities for the last five seasons. Bulls taken average well over 300 B&C most years. Limited space. Now booking for 2010.

Rates: \$10,000 - \$12,000 6 night/5 day ranch elk hunt
\$14,000 6 night/5 day private elk herd hunt

Dates: September – December

Includes: 1X1 guide service, world-class lodging, meals, in-field transportation and trophy care.

Not Included: New Mexico hunting license approx: \$550/hunter, meat processing, commercial flights, rental vehicle charges, hotels & meals prior to hunt and gratuities.

Transportation: Fly into Albuquerque, New Mexico, rent a vehicle & drive to lodge.

British Columbia Premier Mountain Elk Hunt

This outfitter has been a family-run outfitting company for more than 40 years. Located in beautiful British Columbia, this specific hunt takes you to the mountains. Elk and moose are especially plentiful in this mountain area. More than 90% success for six point elk. Six point elk are the rule rather than the exception. Black bear and wolf are always included in this hunt.

Rates: \$8,950 8-Day 1X1 guided elk hunt
Black bear and wolf included in hunt.

Dates: Late August – Mid October

Includes: Black bear and wolves are included in all hunts at no additional charge for harvesting them except for tag/license.

Not Included: 6% Canada Goods and Services Tax, license and tag(s), commercial flights, charter flight approx: \$700 round trip, hotels & meals prior to hunt, dip, pack, crate and shipping of trophy(s) and gratuities.

Transportation: Fly into Fort Nelson, British Columbia & charter into camp.

Northern New Mexico Trophy Bulls

Situated near the border of New Mexico and Colorado, this private ranch has some of the best elk hunting in the state as this is the main migration route for elk in this area. Success has been 95% on bulls in the 280 – 330+ class with an occasional large bull being taken in the 350+ range. A brand new lodge, an experienced outfitter and high numbers of elk make this a first class hunt for someone looking to take a nice 6x6 bull. You can hunt the rut in September or the late season migration of October/November. These hunts are very limited so early booking are advised. Booking for 2009 & 2010.

Rates: \$13,000 5-Day 1X1 private herd elk hunt
\$8,000 5-Day 2X1 general ranch elk hunt
\$6,500 5-Day 2X1 general ranch archery elk hunt

Dates: September - November

Includes: Lodging, meals, field transportation, game processing & services of professional guide.

Not Included: New Mexico state tax, hunting license approx: \$560 / hunter, commercial flights, rental vehicle charges, hotels & meals prior to hunt and gratuities.

Transportation: Fly into Colorado Springs, CO or Albuquerque, New Mexico, rent a vehicle & drive to ranch.

Monster Free-Range Elk

This outfitter specializes in finding and taking big bull elk in Utah, Nevada and Colorado. This is not a hunt for someone just looking to shoot an elk, these guys hunt for bulls in the 350–400+ B&C Class. Their success has been 99% over the past 15 years with 10 bulls making the minimum of 375 B&C the past 5 years. They do extensive scouting and research to find the best areas producing the biggest bulls. These are not cheap hunts, but if you want to hunt the bull of a lifetime, this is where you need to go.

Rates: \$6,500 - \$7,700 6 to 10-Day 1x1 elk hunt
Tag: \$7,000 - \$30,000

Dates: August - November

Includes: Lodging, meals, field transportation, game processing, and services of professional guide.

Not Included: Commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to hunt, license and tag fees, and gratuities.

Transportation: Based on state of hunt.

Colorado Buglers

This is a family run outfit licensed and bonded with over twenty years of experience in the rugged mountains of Northwest Colorado. Located approximately 25 miles from Steamboat Springs, Colorado this magnificent ranch borders the Flattops Wilderness Area and the Routt National Forest. They also hold the National Forest permit to over 110 square miles of prime back-country wilderness. Guided rifle hunters generally have seventy to eighty percent success and archery hunters generally have around eighty percent shooting situations within forty yards. Average elk size is a 5x5.

Rates: \$4,500 5-Day 2x1 elk hunt (cabin private land)
\$3,600 5-Day 2x1 elk hunt (cabin Nat'l Forest)
\$3,000 5-Day 2x1 elk hunt (tent camp Nat'l Forest)

Dates: October - November

Includes: Accommodations, meals, field transportation, game processing, and services of professional guide.

Not Included: Commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to hunt, license fees, and gratuities.

Transportation: Fly into Steamboat Springs, CO. Outfitter will greet upon arrival & transfer to camp.

High Alpine Colorado Elk Hunt

Encompassing 23,000 acres of scenic beauty and prime wildlife habitat, this outfitter offers an idyllic setting for elk hunting. Because this outfitter participates in Colorado's Ranching for Wildlife program, hunters are guaranteed their licenses and big game tags at the time of hunt booking, bypassing the "luck of the draw" tag allocation process. Success rate runs very close to 100%. The guides work very hard to ensure that guests have successful and memorable hunt. Lodging and service is absolutely world-class, meals are prepared by a five-star chef. This is not your typical elk hunt and this lodge must be seen to believe!!

Rates: \$12,500 4-Day 1x1 elk hunt

Dates: September - October

Includes: 1x1 guide service, meals, accommodations, hunting license, trophy care and all in-field transportation.

Not Included: Commercial flights, hotels & meals prior to hunt and gratuities.

Transportation: Fly to Grand Junction, CO. Outfitter will greet upon arrival & transfer to camp.

Big Bulls in Alberta

Elk hunting in the Peace Country has earned the reputation as a "sleeper" due to the growing elk herd populations, rise in age class, and increase in trophy quality. This hunt is a relatively easy, low impact style hunt that is concentrated on the flat farm fields and surrounding timber. Our outfitter and guides will spot and stalk and use various calling techniques to draw the bulls in closer. One very attractive feature about hunting elk in the Peace Country is the fact that we can hunt them with a rifle during the September rut. Elk hunts are 6 days, with a very realistic opportunity at bulls in the 275 – 325 B&C range and can be combo with whitetail, mule deer or moose.

Rates: \$5500 6-day 1x1 Elk hunt

Dates: Mid-September - December

Includes: Lodging, services of professional guide, meals, field preparation of game, and transportation on property.

Not Included: Commercial flights, 3.5% Canada GST, non-resident hunting license approx: \$250, hotels & meals prior to hunt, medical & travel insurance, any gratuities to professional guide, and medical evacuation services.

Transportation: Fly to Grand Prairie, Alberta. Outfitter will greet upon arrival and transfer to camp.
