These aren't your short multiple point stags that score well but look awful –these stags have the genetics to grow very long beams, excellent width and lots of mass; there is no ground-shrinkage whatsoever! This is a great destination to take your wife and/or family as there is a lot to do especially on the South Island. Once you experience hunting with this outfitter you will definitely be planning your return trip!
